Mr. President,

1. I have the honor to deliver this statement on behalf of the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM). The full text is posted on extranet.
2. The NAM welcomes the report of the High Commissioner on the Implementation and enhancement of international cooperation in the field of human rights following the HRC Resolution 53/11.
3. We share the High Commissioner's view as stated in the annual report that the Summit of the Future, scheduled to be held in September 2024, will provide an opportunity to enhance international cooperation in addressing pressing global issues with clear aims to propel the 2030 Agenda forward.
4. The NAM re-echoes the need to promote unity, solidarity, and cooperation among States and we pledge to strive to make a constructive contribution towards building a new pattern of international relations based on the principles of peaceful coexistence, cooperation among nations and the right to equality of all States.
5. We further reaffirm the Movement's commitment to enhance international cooperation to provide humanitarian assistance in full compliance with the UN Charter and mindful of the relevant UN resolution.
6. The Movement underscores the need for international cooperation to enhance productive capacities in developing countries to generate employment and income for all, especially youth and women, and contribute to poverty eradication and achieving sustainable development.
7. Finally, NAM reiterates the important role that genuine human rights dialogue can play in the enhancement of cooperation in the field of human rights at the bilateral, regional, and international levels and calls upon the Council to enforce this.
